Efforts are underway to establish a local KTMP that focuses on integrating wildlife monitoring into public schools through efforts involving students, teachers and community members. Essential to this effort are 20 people who are willing to make a commitment to 6 days of intensive training and 2 evening presentations during the next 8 months and then to monitoring a specific transect with others once each season on an ongoing basis.

Training sessions generally run from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm. Evening classes run from 5:30 pm to 9:15 pm.
